

## GKC Member Spotlight - By Thecla Tyner


### Robert Vandiver, Simpsonville, SC

Robert (Bob) Vandiver originally from Texas. He lived on a small TX Farm. (I'm not sure how small though since most things in TX are rather large!) There his family had mix breed dogs and a horse. He is an Engineering Graduate of Texas A&M University.

In 1966 he married the love of his life, Nancy, an Elementary Education Graduate of University of Northern Iowa. They met when Bob was working in Iowa. During his early working years Bob had to travel for his Career. During their Marriage there were times when Nancy stayed at home and Bob Traveled to Calgary for year and Philadelphia for another year. But then there were times when they both got to live in Brazil for 1.5 years and Holland in the 80's for 2.5 yrs. Traveling was and still is a large part of their life. He retired as a member of the Executive Management Team at one of the largest Engineering and Construction companies in the US, Fluor.

He has had the privileged to judge many specialties and all-breed shows in the US as well as Australia, Canada, China, Europe, India, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Philippines and South America. Some of you will remember that he judged the Westminster Working Group in 2013 and the Herding Group in 2018. Bob has had the opportunity to judge the Westminster Kennel Club Dog show 4 times.
