I hope you all will make a strong effort to be with us on Tues. the 16th. I know Ms. Sharon will have great treats for us as always. Thanks Sharon.


Thank you to all that make our club work. Thank all of you for your support for me and your Board. See You Tuesday the 16th.

April Meeting Location


Our April meeting will be held at the **La Quinta Inn and Suites – Haywood**, 65 West Orchard Park Drive. Greenville 29615.
