This seminar will focus on the why, what and how of puppy evaluations, so that pups are matched to optimal homes where both dog and owner will thrive. Even the best pup won't reach its potential if it isn't in a home where it fits well. The seminar begins with determining why we need to evaluate and match puppies, how to evaluate prospective owners and homes, and evaluating health, structure, and natural working ability. We look at temperament and the components that make dogs more or less successful in their homes. An in-depth look into temperament, identifying those traits that do not change over a dog's lifetime and those that can be influenced by breeders and owners. We will then watch and score an Avidog Puppy Evaluation Test (APET). And try our hand at matching puppies to homes and developing individualized training plans for each pup. After the seminar, all participants will have access to a private resource page on the Avidog website and be invited to join the private The APET Facebook group where we continue the discussions started at the seminar

#### About Gayle

Scientist, retired Army officer, college professor, business owner, and 40-year dog breeder and competitor, Gayle has quite a varied background that she brings to researching and teaching dog lovers that key things we can do in puppyhood so each dog is as healthy and stable over an active lifetime. Gayle has recently been honored as three years in a row as the AKC All-Breed Breeder for the Year for Rally (2016), Agility (2017), and Tracking (2018). She is also a Gold-level AKC Breeder of Merit with over 130 American and Canadian conformation and performance champions, as well as Qualified-All Age and Master Hunters. Gaylan's ability to evaluate puppies and place them in the right homes has been essential to her success. Today, her courses at Avidog University and Avidog-Zink Ventures are the Gold Standard for dog breeder education.

Any member in good standing may nominate any club member they think is deserving of this honor. Nominations are to be made in writing using the Nomination form *(see website)* and submitted to the Board of Directors by November 1st of the year the award is to be given.

#### GKC Member of the Year Award and Selection Procedure

This award honors those individuals who deserve special recognition that have made a difference in the operation and reputation of the Club, consistently excelling in their positions, and demonstrating a strong commitment to the values and goals of the Greenville Kennel Club.

To be considered for nomination, nominees should:

- respect the history, traditions and integrity of the club and of AKC
- commit themselves to values of honesty, courtesy, and contribution to the club
- respect GKC bylaws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures
- welcome, encourage and support new club members, and be willing to share their experience
- always put paramount importance on the welfare of purebred dogs in general
- have been an Active Member in good standing (dues current, regular attendance, etc.) for at least one full year

Note: Members may receive this award no more than once every five (5) years. The award need not be given every year, if no nominations are made, or if nominees do not meet the criteria.

Any member in good standing may nominate any club member they feel is deserving of this honor. Nominations will be made in writing using the Nomination form, to be submitted to the Board by November 1st of the year the award is to be given.
