Anyone planning to make a open nomination from the floor must obtain the agreement and approval of the person being nominated prior to their nomination.)

ARTICLE IV Section 4(b) Upon receipt of the Nominating Committee's report, the Corresponding Secretary shall notify each member in writing of the candidate so nominated at least two (2) weeks before the November meeting, at which additional nominations may be made by any member in attendance provided that the person so nominated does not decline when his name is proposed, and provided further that if the proposed candidate is not in attendance at this meeting, his proposer shall present to the Corresponding Secretary a written statement from the proposed candidate signifying his willingness to be a candidate. No person may be a candidate for more than one position, except for the position of Delegate.

Dear GKC Members,

As you may know, attendance at our monthly meetings has been down over the last few months. Per our By-Laws, we are required to have a quorum of at least 20% of our voting eligible members present to conduct any club business. We did not have a quorum for several of our meetings this year.

While we would love to have all our members attend our meetings, we know that many are not able to regularly attend for various reasons, such as work schedules or transportation issues. Because this affects our ability to maintain quorums at our meetings, we are encouraging those members who are unable to attend to become Associate Members.

Associate Members are non-voting and cannot hold elected office but have all the other privileges as regular members. Associate Members can attend meetings, volunteer at shows and events, attend parties and handling classes at the same cost as Regular Members. They may also serve on committees. The yearly dues for Associate Members are reduced to \$15 per year.

If you would like to convert your membership to Associate, you may do so online by selecting "Convert to Associate Membership" when you pay your 2022 dues online on our website:

https://greenvillekc.org/index.php/dues.

If you pay by mail or at a meeting, you can do so by signing a slip that will be enclosed with your printed invoice.

Conversion to Associate Membership is completely voluntary and if your situation changes you may revert to Regular Membership at any time.

We are already looking forward to next year and hoping to make it just as wonderful!


