

## **The Role of Sponsors and Mentors**

An applicant does not need to have sponsors in advance before applying for membership in the Greenville Kennel Club. It's helpful, but not mandatory. If the applicant does not know any member of the club, he/she will be assigned a mentor to start the process.

The mentor will contact the applicant via phone call, or personally, and get to know them and their goals in joining the club. It is recommended that the applicant attend several meetings to get to know some of the members as well. If the mentor is satisfied that GKC is a good fit, then he/she will help in finding two appropriate sponsors who will take over the process in more depth.

A sponsor's role is to meet with or converse with applicants and determine their areas of interest, their areas of expertise, which then in turn helps them find their niche in the club's activities, and allows the sponsor to direct you to members who can best help you with your own interests and training. It is also the sponsor's role to be a resource for the applicant to answer questions about a particular activity, about the club's policies on any particular item, about how anything works within the club, to simply be a sounding board for the applicant until that is no longer seriously needed.

Become a friend in the club! Sponsors, mentors, and indeed the entire membership, serve as guides for new members and are there to help and provide support, guidance, information or advice whenever needed.


