Speaker: *Jordan G. Smith* is a doctoral student in the Cognitive and Behavioral Sciences Program at Auburn University. She holds a B.S. in Biology from Bob Jones University in Greenville, SC and a M.S in Psychology from Auburn University. After finishing her undergraduate degree, Jordan was a research assistant at the Penn Vet Working Dog Center in Philadelphia, PA where she participated in research with scent-detection dogs, specifically working on an ovarian cancer detection study and conducting behavioral evaluations on working dogs in training.

Jordan is currently a graduate research assistant at Canine Performance Sciences and a member of the Comparative Cognition Laboratory. Her current research examines the impact of early olfactory experiences on the behavioral and cognitive development of working dogs, as well as how olfactory enrichment and odor discrimination training during early development impacts odor detection proficiency as an adult. She also assists on other projects at Canine Performance Sciences and with pet dogs in the local community exploring cognitive development, odor memory, odor detection thresholds, and how cognitive tasks can be used as a measure of working dog success.




Favorite dog memory- Making the finals at the Westminster Dog Show, making the finals two years in a row at the AKC National Championship and lots of scholarship wins!


