Smyth, Esq. – a breeder judge early in PBGV history in the US. Professional handler Connor Black of KC Handling really made Willi shine. It was so special to be presented the AKC National Championship medallion for Opposite Sex that the Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen Club of America sponsored. ○

This was Savvi Saveurs' first huge show and she was a tired puppy after the 9 hour drive and all the excitement of the large convention center. Saveur still hasn't got stacking down and does not understand staying still for a few seconds She was awarded first in her Bred By Exhibitor class on Saturday by Judge Daniel Smyth. Overall we thought she did well for a fun loving PBGV puppy that was wide eyed at all the things going on around her.

Tipsy Pompette stayed home with Rowdy this trip as she helps take care of him. Rowdy has arthritis and cannot scratch his head anymore so he goes to the gate, lowers his head and Tipsy scratches his head. He also doesn't hear or see well (he will be 14 years old January 19) but granddaughter Tipsy guides her Gramps. When it is time to go out Tipsy bumps Rowdy to get him going. When we call them in, Tipsy goes to get Gramps and nudges him to let him know it is time to come in and what direction to head. Tipsy always respects Rowdy and watches out for him. Hopefully next year we will get her out to play some in the conformation ring.

In late November at the Speedway Classic in Concord, NC Savvi Saveur celebrated her 12 month birthday a day early going Best Bred By Exhibitor, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners for a major and Owner Handled Best of Breed under Judge Ms. Kimberly Anne Meredith. Then in a small but quality Owner Handled Hound Group Savvi got her first OH Group Placement going Group Two under Judge Ms. Edweena (Teddy) McDowell. Her mom Willett was Opposite Sex showing with handler Connor Black. Savvi's dad Nelson was Best of Breed. So the line up was Sire, Daughter, Dam. Willett picked up Grand Champion points all four days in Concord by going Best Opposite Sex two days and Select two days. Willi and Connor are making a great team.

In early December we headed the Perry shows for two days where Savvi Saveur was awarded a few more points. She went Bred By Exhibitor, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and BOB Owner Handled the two days she was entered, award by Judges Mr. Thomas Kirstein and Mr. James J. Mitchell. Now our energetic girl has both her majors and 11 points.

Willett received her Scent Work Novice title at the end of October. Tony has done a great job training and handling Willi in Scent Work and all the girls in the hunting field. The StoneHouseHound girls did a great job at the December Carolina PBGV Hunt with Willett running solos and the puppies passing the Hunting Instinct Test. Willett's solo runs had some of the highest scores both days at 165 on Saturday and 173.3 Sunday. Pending certification, Willi got her Senior Hunter Excellent title Saturday flushing a rabbit in the first two minutes of being let go. Sunday she did it again except quicker by flushing a rabbit in the first 60 seconds. Savvi Saveur and Tipsy Pompette passed their Hunting Instinct Test (HIT) Saturday and hunted in a pack on Sunday. Both have a long way to go but scored 97. They never voiced and didn't pack well with the other two PBGVs. Overall it was a good weekend in the hunt field.

#### Our Road to Rally Championship Definitely a journey that requires dedication, and perseverance!

Violet was from my Valentine litter born; 2/14/2016 Jenny X Ritz: Named Violet after my own mother. Ky's Wynn'N Violet Valentine Dam: GCH Ky's CJ Watch'N Me Wynn JH ROM and Sire: CH Banker's Goal Standard

I kept the puppy from this litter that was the most active and outgoing. I was not going to put her with a family that might have trouble with her. Boy did I ever begin a journey with her!

She was full of excitement! She wanted to please, very biddable, however she wanted to do things her way and hopefully make me pleased! LOL Well she definitely makes me smile and laugh! I had never had a Vizsla that was this over the top. She thought that the Conformation Game was to beat the other dogs around the ring. And believe me she tried. During her show career gained a-4 major and 9 total points with many Reserve Winners! But at 2 she began to turn grey, not welcomed by the judges. Her Great Grandma was totally gray at 8 years old, and Violet began to be on her way to take after her Great Grandma.

Whether I was to keep her, or rehome her, I had to get her trained! My husband called her a hoodlum, a renegade. But I claimed her to be a handful, to say the least. She was and still is a handful, but she is my handful!

I began some obedience classes, 5 to be exact (1 session) Late Summer of 2017 at 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  years old. I moved her to Rally and never looked back!

10/15/2017 she earned her Rally Novice Title in 3 straight passes

11/5/2017 Violet achieved her Junior Hunter Title in 4 straight passes

3/17/2018 Violet earned her Intermediate Title in 4 passes, because her handler didn't get a walk thru and did a figure 8 around the wrong two cones!

6/8/2018 Violet earned her Rally Advanced, (this is off leash) in 3 straight passes

3/24/2019 Violet earned her Rally Excellent Title in 3 straight passes, placing 1<sup>st</sup> in Rally Excellent at.the VCA National Rally Trial that year.

Covid in the Spring of 2020 and getting started back in 2021

2/24/2021 Violet earn her CGC Title

6/4/2021 Violet earned her CGCU Title

6/19/2021 Violet Earned her RM Rally Master Title

12/5/2021 Violet earned her RAE (Rally Advance Excellent) Title (Qualifying in both Advance and Excellent in the same trial 10 times.)

5/7/2022 Violet Earned her RAE 2 Title

3/26/2022 Violet Earned her RM 2 Title

8/21/2022 Violet Earned her RM 3 Title

12/3/2022 Violet Earned her RM 4 Title

And "drum roll" on 12/4/2022 Violet EARNED her RACH (Rally Championship Title).

At the ripe old age of 6.5.

Once attempting the RAE Title, she Qualified every time she attempted those two classes!

Once Violet started working on her Master Title, she Qualified 35 times of the 39 attempted. Only 4 times did she not Qualify. (Mostly due to handler mistakes LOL). It's definitely a team effort!


